Chloe was reading at a low kindergarten level in third grade. The extra time she spent with us in REC where she read aloud and practiced reading comprehension helped boost her reading confidence. We noticed it ourselves, but so did her teacher who stopped me in the hallway and thanked us. She said Chloe grew from a score of "C" (kindergarten level) to "1" (high first grade) in three months of reading practice. Her parents also said that they have seen a change in Chloe's willingness to read on her own without being prompted. While Chloe still falls a little short to where she's supposed to be, she now feels motivated to continue practicing and engage in reading a book without fear.
